

## Alice POWER - CV (Eng) 2025

Alice Power is a Swedish pianist, born into a family of professional musicians in 2000. At the age of 5 she started playing the piano with her mother and grandmother. Alice is a laureate of several scholarships and international competitions in France, Sweden, Italy, Georgia, Germany, Poland, Spain. In 2017 she first meets professor Rena Shereshevskaya and takes part in several masterclasses of hers. This life-changing meeting makes Alice move to Paris in 2021 to start her studies in professor Shereshevskaya's class at École Normale de Musique de Paris Alfred Cortot. In May 2025 Alice is awarded the prestigious Prix Cortot right after receiving her Artist Diploma with highest honours.

Alice has performed in most of Sweden's biggest venues, in 2017 with the Stockholm Philharmonic Orchestra on the occasion of the annual opening of the Swedish government for all members of the Swedish royal family and the Swedish parliament, in Salle Cortot in Paris, Rosey Concert Hall in Switzerland, the Radio House of Wroclaw, Frédéric Chopin's summer house in Poland, at the Royal Palace of Sweden, as well as in China, England, Romania, Jordan, Italy, Norway, Georgia, Cyprus, France - with Stockholm Philharmonic Orchestra, the Wroclaw University Philharmonic Orchestra, the Vasteras Sinfonietta Orchestra and also performs regularly in different chamber music groups. She released a single for European Gramophone in 2024 and will release her first solo-album in 2026 for the label La Dolce Volta in France.

She has worked with renowned musicians Renaud Capuçon, Gábor Takács-Nagy, Rafael Payare, Christian Lindberg, Marc Soustrot, and others. Alice is regularly invited to international music festivals in Sweden, France and abroad. In 2023 she was invited to participate in a gala concert for Princess Christina of Sweden (the sister of Swedish King Carl Gustaf) 80th birthday celebration.

Since 2011 Alice has also been a guest artist in the very famous Swedish show "Rhapsody in Rock" created by pianist/composer Robert Wells. They have toured together many years and have performed in most of Sweden's big concert halls and arenas, as well as in England and China, with numerous performances on international television.

Alice obtained her Master Degree in Musicology and Piano Interpretation in 2023 after having written a big thesis about musical rhetorics and J.S.Bach. Today, she is working with professor Rena Shereshevskaya in Paris, as well as actively performing in Europe. Before moving to Paris she was studying at the Norwegian Academy of Music in Oslo (w. M.Shirinyan) at the Royal College of Music in Stockholm for her Bachelor of Music, and in 2024 Alice was as well one of the soloists of the International Menuhin Music Academy in Switzerland. In summer 2025 Alice was programmed for festivals like the Chopin Nohant Festival in France, touring in Sweden as well as joining the Gstaad Menuhin Festival Academy, invited by Sir Ándras Schiff. Apart from music Alice loves to travel, read and study different languages.
